There will be a midweek worship service and study at Calvary on Thursday at 11:30 a.m., followed by noon Eucharist and study.

During Holy Week, March 29 through April 2, a devotion and simple lunch will be served. Church location will be announced at a later date.

On Maundy Thursday, April 1, Calvary will offer a service at 7:30 p.m.

A Good Friday service will be offered at Calvary on April 2, at 7:00 p.m.

This Year's Lenten Devotional

"The Preaching of the Passion," a book by the Rev'd. Peter Gomes, minister of the Chapel at Harvard University, will be used as the Lenten Devotional this year. Through a passionate series of essays, Gomes offers a moving look at Jesus' final words from the Cross--examining not the physical horror of Christ's last hours, but instead His dialogue with His Father. Join us on Thursdays during Lent, beginning February 18th with a simple meal at 11:30am, follow by Eucharist and study. Books are available through the office at Calvary Church. For those unable to attend during the day, this study will also be offered in the evenings at Christ Church in Ironton at 6 pm., beginning Wednesday, February 24th.
