DISCIPLES COURSE

The new adult education course continues this week at 9:30 a.m. It will run for approximately 8 more weeks and is entitled "Invitation to John." Session 1 was called "Come and See," Session 2 was called "How Is It Possible," Session 3 is called "Taste for Yourself," Session 4 is called "To Believe or Not to Believe," Session 5 is called "Are We Blind," Session 6 is called "I Couldn't Believe My Eyes," Session 7 is called "Would You Believe It," Session 8 is "What Time Is It," Session 9 is called "Look Out," Session 10 is called "Believing Without Seeing," and Session 11 is called "Do You See Him."

Each session will include a 15 - 20 minute video followed by discussion. The sessions will be facilitated by the Adult Education Committee of the Vestry in the Parish Hall.
