**Vestry Sets Stewardship Pace
With lead Pledges!**

Many thanks to our Vestry whose combined pledges total \$63,400, which is 42% of the total received from the parish so far. 42 cards have been received for \$150,760, which is about 50% of the amount we will need for operations in 2009. The average Vestry pledge is \$5,763 and the combined parish average is \$3,589. If you have not been able to turn in your card yet, please do so ASAP. The stewardship Committee will be making follow-up calls soon.

To help families use this four week session as a time of spiritual preparation for Christmas a special daily devotional booklet has been prepared for use at the family dinner table.
